

Jason Williams is Principal Member of Technical Staff at AT&T Labs – Research, where he has been since 2006. He received a BSE in Electrical Engineering from Princeton University in 1998, and at Cambridge University he received an M Phil in Computer Speech and Language Processing in 1999 and a Ph D in Information Engineering in 2006. His main research interests are dialog management, the design of spoken language systems, and planning under uncertainty.
